OUR MISSION

The mission of the Sacred Art Institute at Enders Island is to preserve our heritage and to create fine sacred arts while promoting the highest standards of excellence in the sacred arts.

SPIRITUALITY

Workshops combine hands-on instruction with the sacramental and prayer life of the Church. Mass is offered daily in the beautiful Chapel of Our Lady of the Assumption, which features the sacred artwork of several of the masters who teach at the Institute.

Each morning session begins with a brief centering prayer. Each afternoon closes with twenty minutes of spiritual input and sharing.

ACCOMMODATIONS

We provide our students with newly renovated, fully outfitted studio space within which participants pursue their creative ambitions. We provide high-quality and delicious meals, and full use of the Institute facilities.



ABOUT ENDERS ISLAND

Enders Island is an 11-acre island off the coast of Mason's Island in Mystic, CT. The grounds of Enders Island include a 360° ocean view, beautiful walking gardens, a Seaside Chapel, an outdoor Stations of the Cross, and iconic facilities including the Enders Mansion and the Catholic Chapel of Our Lady of the Assumption, which houses the incorrupt arm of St. Edmund of Canterbury (1175–1240). Enders Island has 3 primary ministries:

ST. EDMUND'S RETREAT

Featuring a Bed & Breakfast, private retreats, and an extensive array of programs open to people of all faiths: Speaker Series, Days of Recollection; Day, Weekend, and Week-long Retreats for men, women, clergy, married couples, and a variety of special interest groups. Bereavement programs are also available throughout the year for those mourning the death of a loved one.

THE SACRED ART INSTITUTE



CREATE BEAUTIFUL WORKS OF ART SURROUNDED BY GARDENS & THE OCEAN

All of our workshops take place on beautiful Enders Island, Mystic, Connecticut, where participants are surrounded by spectacular water views. Spring and Fall are particularly beautiful times on the Island. Our programs combine hands-on instruction with prayer and the sacramental life of the Church. Because we limit enrollments and employ only select instructors with significant experience, we are able to accommodate participation at all levels of proficiency, from beginners to experts.

AFTERNOON STUDIO SESSIONS

Afternoon Studio Sessions are special one-time opportunities to explore your creative side by participating in a brief, hands-on sacred art instruction. Our studio sessions begin with a 3-course hot served lunch and typically last a total of two to three hours.

EVENING ENRICHMENT WORKSHOPS

Evening Enrichment Workshops are divided into 12 consecutive weeks, one evening every week. Each evening begins with a 3-course dinner at 5:30 pm and concludes at 9:15 pm.

WEEK-LONG INTENSIVE WORKSHOPS

Our week-long workshops last five consecutive days beginning with a 5:30 pm dinner on Sunday night for students and instructors. The Sunday evening program continues with an introduction, a conference, and a brief period of studio time which ends at 9:30 pm. Hands-on instruction begins mid-morning on Monday following the 9 am Mass. The week concludes with a 12:00 pm lunch on Friday. Instruction reaches 40 hours during a week-long program and workshops are paced so that participants leave with a finished work of art or final recording. During Friday morning Mass, a priest will bless students' artwork before departure.

We provide participants with comfortable overnight accommodations, high-quality and delicious meals, and full use of the Institute facilities. Commuters are also welcome to participate in our programs. Mass is offered

daily in the beautiful Chapel of Our Lady of the Assumption, which features the sacred artwork of several of the masters who have taught at the Institute.
